You should attempt to do at least one of these activities



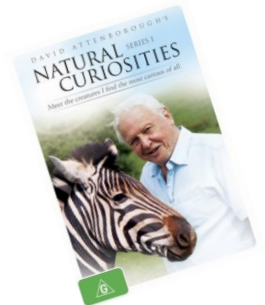
History

- Research a Tudor monarch and create a fact file. (Henry VII, Henry VIII, Edward VI, Mary I, Elizabeth I)
- Visit the National Maritime Museum in Greenwich and look round the Empire exhibition
- Travel out of London as a family and visit Mountfitchet Castle near Stansted. This is a unique open-air museum where you can witness life in a Motte and Bailey Castle – something we will be looking at next term in History.



Geography

- Visit Epping Forest and go for a walk – have a look at what flora and fauna you can spot
- Check the news regularly and follow any stories relating to Geography – e.g floods or storms
- Watch David Attenborough's Natural Curiosities on 'W'



Religious Studies

- Follow developments in the Middle East on the news – write down what you watch
- Visit Westminster Abbey or St Pauls Cathedral or another church close to you to explore a Christian place of worship.
