

Sixth Form Dress Code

This dress code applies to all Sixth Form students commencing 1st November, 2021.

- Suit or Blazer with Trousers/ Knee-length Skirt/ Knee-length Dress
- Shirt/Blouse – long/short sleeve
- Waistcoat/V-Neck jumper/Cardigan (worn underneath blazer)
- Tie/Bowtie
- Shoes (closed toe only due to H&S)
- Cultural/religious attire
- No revealing/inappropriate clothing.
- Jewellery must not be excessive and must be appropriate to the tasks being completed from a H&S perspective.
- Piercings: Ears and Single nose studs are permitted.
- For over-18 years olds, tattoos do not need to be intentionally covered up, as long as they are not offensive or politically motivated. We ask students to approach the Head / Deputy Head of Sixth Form if they are unsure about the appropriateness of their tattoos that can be easily seen.
- *Note: outdoor garments e.g. coats, hats scarves, gloves are not to be worn inside the building*
