



EQUIPMENT/BANNED ITEMS

ESSENTIAL ITEMS

These are essential items for students' learning and must be brought to school every day and taken to every lesson.

- ✓ Student organiser
- ✓ Scientific calculator
- ✓ Reading book
- ✓ PE kit, if required
- ✓ Books/folders for that day's lessons
- ✓ A clear plastic water bottle
- ✓ Pencil case with the following:
 - at least 2 black or blue writing pens and a green pen
 - 2 sharp pencils
 - a rubber and a sharpener
 - a 30cm ruler
 - a highlighter pen
 - a protractor
 - a glue stick
 - white board marker pens

BANNED ITEMS

These items are banned on the Academy site as they may be detrimental to students' learning, their own or others' health and safety, or cause damage to Academy property. The consequences for bringing these items onto the school site are outlined in the Positive Behaviour for Learning Policy.

- × Food and drink, other than water
- × Chewing gum
- × Non uniform items
- × Mobile telephones
- × Electrical items and personal entertainment equipment
- × Aerosols
- × Correction fluid
- × Glass bottles
- × Dangerous items including any item that might potentially be used as a weapon
- × Alcohol, drugs, cigarettes, matches, e-cigarettes

You must hand their mobile phone into the Student Reception by 8.25 each day. You should collect your phone just prior to leaving the school premises. If you do not comply with this rule your phone will be confiscated. Your parents/carers will need to arrange to collect the phone from Mr Athwal or Mr Ball in person at his convenience.
