**Subject: Key Stage 3 PE lessons**

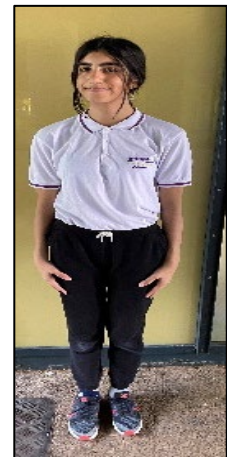
Dear Parent/Carer,

As you are aware, the academy is constantly reviewing procedures to ensure that teaching, learning and progress can be maximised in the presence of COVID-19. In light of this, the decision has been made for all students in Year 7, 8, and 9 to wear full PE kit to school on the days that they have PE lessons. This will be effective from Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October 2020. The reasoning of this decision is due to staff capacity and the safety of each child.

On the day your child has PE they must arrive to school wearing their full PE kit, blazer and lanyard.

The Isaac Newton PE kit is as follows:

- White INA Polo Top
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms/shorts/leggings
- Black socks
- Any colour sporting trainers
- Optional: Black/white under layer
- Optional: INA rain jacket



Please note that no other items of sportswear should be worn on arrival to the academy or in P.E. lessons. A visual example of how students should present themselves is shown above.

Your child must also ensure they bring their full school uniform with them in their bags. The reason that school uniform is required is in the event of bad weather we would require students to get changed after the lesson to ensure that they are comfortable for the rest of the school day. The items they must have in their bag are as follows:

- Tie
- Shirt
- Trousers/Skirt
- School shoes
