Dear Year 11 parent / carer,

I wanted to write to you this morning to ensure you were clear about the process today and how to contact the school should you have questions.

The results students receive today will not be based on formal exams this year. Instead they will be based on the grades that we submitted (Centre Assessed Grades), or the Calculated Grade from the exam board, whichever is the higher. In generating the Centre Assessed Grades, we used all the relevant data about your child alongside teacher assessment.

It will be a time of celebration for many, but some students may be disappointed with their grades. We have confidence in the process we went through to decide each grade, but if your child remains unhappy with any of their results, and you wish to discuss this further please do not hesitate to contact us. In normal circumstances, you would be able to accompany your child today but this is not possible due to the Covid safety measures in place. Our priority is that all our students take the right next step in their education. Staff will be available today to enrol students into our Sixth Form and to discuss the best options for your child next year.
