The welfare and safety of our students is our priority, and we will take whatever action is necessary and appropriate to ensure their safety, both within the school community and outside. We will be communicating with relevant year groups via assemblies and providing support from trained professionals to any student that may require it.

This issue serves to demonstrate the vitally important work we do in educating our students to help make a positive difference in the world around them. We remain fully committed to promoting the values and beliefs that we hold dear, to help shape peaceful and safe communities for all.
